GESD announces schedule for volunteer fingerprinting opportunities

GLENDALE, Ariz. — The Glendale Elementary School District (GESD) has scheduled monthly fingerprinting opportunities for parents, guardians and community members who would like to participate in school-related volunteer activities.

All fingerprinting sessions will be held at the Glendale Elementary School District Offices, 7301 N. 58th Ave., from 8:30 a.m. until 3 p.m. During the 2011-12 school year, volunteers can be fingerprinted on these dates:

Aug. 10	Jan. 25
Sept. 14	Feb. 8
Oct. 19	March 21
Nov. 16	April 11
Dec. 7	May 2

The safety of GESD students is the primary reason for fingerprinting volunteers. The fingerprint cards are cleared through the Arizona Department of Public Safety. Parents, guardians and community members who want to participate in school-related volunteer activities must, according to District policy, be fingerprinted. Volunteers also must fill out a volunteer application from their a GESD school office. Volunteer applications must be signed by either the school's principal or assistant principal. Everyone seeking to be fingerprinted must bring either a valid Arizona Drivers License / ID, or a U.S. Government-issued ID. Both must include physical descriptions of the ID holder. Volunteer applicants are not eligible to participate in school-related volunteer activities until their volunteer clearance information is distributed to schools.
